- Au cours des dernières décennies, les historiens de l'art ont réinterprété sous un nouvel angle le legs historique de l'impressionnisme, revendiquant son influence sur l'évolution de certains aspects de l'abstraction de la seconde moitié du XXe siècle. L'exposition Monet et l'abstraction se joint à cette tendance, dans l'optique de souligner son rôle dans le développement de la modernité. Situons-nous dans les dernières années du XIXe siècle. Dans son obsession de capter l'instantanéité, Claude Monet, le plus représentatif et prolifique, mais aussi le plus indépendant et novateur des impressionnistes français, finit par estomper la représentation picturale pour l'imprégner d'une atmosphère quasi abstraite. Son intérêt pour des questions telles que la perception de la nature et son besoin d'exprimer son vécu par des moyens purement picturaux le conduiront aux frontières de l'abstraction. Cependant, lors des premières décennies du XXe siècle, alors que s'imposent les nouvelles tendances de l'avant-garde, essentiellement fondées sur le concept de « construction », l'oeuvre de Monet - comme celle de la plupart des impressionnistes, à l'exception de Cézanne - est taxée d'anachronisme et tombe dans l'oubli le plus complet. La preuve en est que sa mort, en décembre 1926, passera pratiquement inaperçue, tandis que ses Grandes Décorations, inaugurées un an plus tard au Musée de l'Orangerie, seront ignorées durant plusieurs décennies. Ce n'est qu'au milieu du XXe siècle que l'on assiste à la « redécouverte » de Monet, lorsque les jeunes chefs de file triomphants de l'expressionnisme abstrait américain lancent un nouveau regard sur son oeuvre. La matérialité de sa peinture, sa technique « all-over », ses touches vives et ses formes estompées sont une véritable révélation pour la jeune génération de l'abstraction américaine, mais aussi pour les adeptes des informalismes européens. L'étude de ce revival de Monet par le mouvement abstrait a donné lieu à de nombreuses initiatives ces dernières années, auxquelles s'ajoute aujourd'hui cette exposition, qui confronte les tableaux du peintre impressionniste avec l'oeuvre d'artistes tels que Pollock, Rothko, Krasner, Francis, Mitchell, Riopelle, Still, Gottlieb, Masson ou Richter. Elle propose ainsi une nouvelle lecture de ces

artistes, tout en démontrant le rôle de Monet en tant que prophète indiscutable des courants « matériques » de la peinture abstraite.

When the Nazis came to power and created a racial state in the 1930s, an urgent priority was to identify Jews who had converted to Christianity over the preceding centuries. With the help of church officials, a vast system of conversion and intermarriage records was created in Berlin, the country's premier Jewish city. Deborah Hertz's discovery of these records, the *Judenkartei*, was the first step on a long research journey that has led to this compelling book. Hertz begins the book in 1645, when the records begin, and traces generations of German Jewish families for the next two centuries. The book analyzes the statistics and explores letters, diaries, and other materials to understand in a far more nuanced way than ever before why Jews did or did not convert to Protestantism. Focusing on the stories of individual Jews in Berlin, particularly the charismatic salon woman Rahel Levin Varnhagen and her husband, Karl, a writer and diplomat, Hertz humanizes the stories, sets them in the context of Berlin's evolving society, and connects them to the broad sweep of European history.

One of the most influential painters of modern times, Claude Monet lived for half his life in the famous house at Giverny. It was after moving here in 1883 with his future second wife, Alice Hoschedézanne -- other regular guests included Rodin, Whistler, Maupassant, Valéry, and one of Monet's closest friends, the statesman Clemenceau. They came to dine in almost ritual form, first visiting Monet's studio and the greenhouses, then having lunch at 11:30 (the time the family always dined, to enable Monet to make the most of the afternoon light). Tea would later be served under the lime trees or near the pond. Guests were never invited to dinner; because Monet went to bed very early in order to rise at dawn. All the guests were familiar with Monet's rigid timetable. The recipes collected in his cooking journals include dishes Monet had encountered in his travels or had come across in restaurants he frequented in Paris as well as recipes from friends, such as Cézanne's bouillabaisse and Millet's petits pains. For this book, the author Claire Joyes, wife of Madame Monet's great-grandson, has spent years selecting the Monets' favorite recipes and writing a wonderfully evocative introductory text. All of the recipes have been artfully prepared and brought back to life in Monet's own kitchen by master chef Joël Robuchon. Illustrated with sumptuous reproductions of Monet's paintings, spectacular original four-color photographs of Giverny, selected shots of finished dishes, and facsimile pages from the notebooks themselves, this book provides a fascinating and unique

insight into the turn-of-the-century lifestyle of one of the world's most celebrated Impressionist painters.

Nick Cave is now widely recognized as a songwriter, musician, novelist, screenwriter, curator, critic, actor and performer. From the band, *The Boys Next Door* (1976-1980), to the spoken-word recording, *The Secret Life of the Love Song* (1998), to the recently acclaimed screenplay of *The Proposition* (2005) and the *Grinderman* project (2008), Cave's career spans thirty years and has produced a comprehensive (and sometimes controversial) body of work that has shaped contemporary alternative culture. Despite intense media interest in Cave, there have been remarkably few comprehensive appraisals of his work, its significance and its impact on understandings of popular culture. In addressing this absence, the present volume is both timely and necessary. *Cultural Seeds* brings together an international range of scholars and practitioners, each of whom is uniquely placed to comment on an aspect of Cave's career. The essays collected here not only generate new ways of seeing and understanding Cave's contributions to contemporary culture, but set up a dialogue between fields all-too-often separated in the academy and in the media. Topics include Cave and the Presley myth; the aberrant masculinity projected by *The Birthday Party*; the postcolonial Australian-ness of his humour; his interventions in film and his erotics of the sacred. In *Debating Procreation*, David Benatar and David Wasserman take opposing views on this important question. David Benatar argues for the anti-natalist view that it is always wrong to bring new people into existence. He argues that coming into existence is always a serious harm and that even if it were not always so, the risk of serious harm is sufficiently great to make procreation wrong. In addition to these "philanthropic" arguments, he advances the "misanthropic" one that because humans are so defective and cause vast amounts of harm, it is wrong to create more of them. David Wasserman defends procreation against the anti-natalist challenge. He outlines a variety of moderate pro-natalist positions, which all see procreation as often permissible but never required. After criticizing the main anti-natalist arguments, he reviews those pronatalist positions. He argues that constraints on procreation are best understood in terms of the role morality of prospective parents, considers different views of that role morality, and argues for one that imposes only limited constraints based on the well-being of the future child. He then argues that the expected good of a future child and of the parent-child relationship can provide a strong justification for procreation in the face of expected adversities without giving individuals any moral reason to procreate
