The Ibizan Hound, like the name suggests, is a breed of dog that is a member of the hound family. The Ibizan Hound has an elegant and agile frame but also has good bone girth which makes it a hardy and all

around rugged breed. The breed's distinguishing feature is its large upright ears. The Ibizan Hound's coat can come in two varieties: wiry and smooth. Smooth coats tend to be very short while wiry coats (which are dramatically more rare) can range in length from 1 to 3 inches. The temperament of dogs is normally affected by the following factors: individual personality, heredity, training and socialization. It is therefore important to make sure that you meet the puppy's mother before purchasing a Ibizan Hound. It is also important to make sure to thoroughly socialize your Ibizan Hound with strangers, children and other animals during its puppyhood.
